

CDCA Allergy Plan

2022/2023

In the event of a medical emergency, staff would immediately call 911 and report the type of emergency and the location of CDCA. CDCA is located at 16075 Hawthorn Path, Lakeville, MN 55044. An AED (Automated External Defibrillator) is available in the back of the sanctuary upstairs. All staff personnel are trained in First Aid, CPR, Bloodborne Pathogens, Allergy Prevention & Response, Abusive Head Trauma & Mandated Reporting.

Before admitting a child with a known allergy, documentation from the child's parent and medical source must be obtained with current information about the child's allergy.

An Individual Child Care Program Plan must be in place including a description of the allergy, specific triggers, avoidance techniques, symptoms of an allergic reaction, and procedures for responding to the allergic reaction. This should include: medication, dosage and doctor contact information. Parents should keep the school updated if there are any changes to this plan. Staff must be informed of this plan and a staff review documentation kept on site. This must be updated annually.

Allergy information must be available at all times on site and on field trips.

Parents must be informed of any allergy exposure including any that required medication or medical intervention. A log will be available to record any medication administration.
