Per Minnesota Statutes, chapter 245A.41 subdivision 1 the license holder must:

• Contact the child's parent or legal guardian as soon as possible in any instance of exposure or allergic reaction that requires medication or medical intervention; and

• Call emergency medical services when epinephrine is administered to a child in the license holder's care. **Doctor information - Call 911 for EMERGENCIES** DOCTOR NAME DOCTOR PHONE NUMBER Allergy information available at all times A child's allergy information must be available at all times, including on-site, when on field trips, or during transportation. Food allergy information must be readily available to a staff person in the area where food is prepared and served to the child per. Minnesota Statutes, chapter 245A.41, subdivision 1. Minnesota Rules, part 9503.0125 states that license holders shall not disclose a child's record without parent permission. If the center posts child's allergy information in a location visible to others in the program, parental permission is required. By checking "Lagree" and typing my name in the "Electronic Signature" field, I understand that I am electronically signing this form.
